He was educated in Boston at the New England School of Art and Design and the School of Visual Arts in New York. Tony is a Signature Member of the New England Watercolor Society, a Russell Galley Artist and member of the Plymouth Center for the Arts, The Duxbury Art Association, and an Associate Member of the National Watercolor Society.
