WE'LL STUDY:

- The importance of contrast
- Study and application of light, shadow and contrast
- How to paint warm and cold shadows
- Distinction between soft and hard shadows
- How to connect shadow and volume
- Tonal variations present in shadows
- Shadow behavior on colored backgrounds.

At the end of each day, we will paint a human figure, applying the knowledge that was shared during the course days.
